Growing Through Grief

Socializing is one of the most difficult yet necessary activities after losing a spouse or partner. It can be especially hard when interacting with people who don't understand what you've been through.

In 2022, Trish Bowers, bereavement counselor and one of the facilitators of Hospice's Spousal and Partner Loss Support Group, began organizing monthly meetups between participants who have "graduated" from the original group and are ready to take another step in navigating life after losing a spouse or partner.

"Just because your person died, your living moments don't stop," says Trish. "These expanded gatherings create a safe and soft place for people to land while figuring out how to continue having their own living moments."

Trish wanted to create a space where people could gather socially without having to talk about loss, while knowing they are among others who understand what they are going through. The first few gatherings were held at Hospice and became more popular when moved to Worman's Mill, which allowed for a larger space and Worman's Mill residents to join.

A Christmas potluck was the first event held at Worman's Mill. Since then, Trish has organized other monthly events like coffee and bagel mornings, game nights, potlucks and volunteering for organizations including Blessings in a Backpack. These gatherings have been life-changing.

"I have found true joy in volunteering at Hospice and Worman's Mill for those less fortunate, whether I'm making a warm blanket for those that are homeless or packing an inspirational note and food for a hungry child," says Lucille Layne, who joined the support group in April 2022.

Now, participants have begun to meet outside of scheduled Hospice events. Throughout these expanded gatherings, the original group has grown to include others looking to socialize with those who understand the complex feelings surrounding losing a spouse or partner.

Maureen Springer joined the original spousal and partner loss support group in April 2022, nearly 4 months after losing her husband, Glenn. Toward the end of the sessions, a member invited everyone to her home for a summer potluck, beginning a series of social gatherings that continue today. Those who attended the cookout - about 5 or 6 of the original group, including Lucille - planned a monthly Saturday morning coffee meetup. Saturday coffee, along with volunteering and events at Worman's Mill, quickly became a saving grace. As the group's bond strengthened, they organized more meetups, with some members even attending a weekly trivia night. Their team name? "Good Grief."

"Sharing these times with people who 'get it' and know what we are going through was instrumental in my survival," says Maureen. "I don't know where I'd be without this group of very special friends."

In the fall of 2023, Maureen attended a potluck organized by Trish at Worman's Mill. Since Glenn passed, Maureen had not cooked many meals but found herself excited to make a dish to share.

"Looking back, I discovered that these hospice-related events gave me something to look forward to," says Maureen.

"I never thought I would come out of the dark, but my group has helped me find the light. I don't know where I would be today without Hospice. I can't even describe how grateful I am to have the privilege to be counseled by Trish and my newfound lifelong friends."

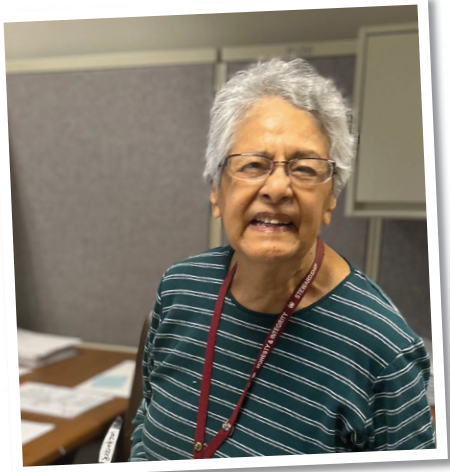

Demystifying Hospice Care

When someone is facing a life-limiting illness, receiving personalized support, comfort and dignity can make a world of difference. In these instances, hospice care is a crucial option for managing pain, improving quality of life and providing emotional support. But due to lingering misconceptions, many eligible people miss out on the important benefits offered by hospice.

The sentiment, "I don't want hospice, I want to stay home," reflects a common misunderstanding that hospice is a place. But hospice care is not confined to a specific location; it can be delivered in various settings, including a patient's home or an inpatient facility. Hospice clients can also keep their own doctor, which provides a sense of familiarity and continuity during a stressful time.

Entering hospice care does not mean that the person is "giving up hope." Instead, it marks a shift in focus towards maximizing the quality of life rather than continuing life-prolonging medical treatments. Hospice care is not a surrender; instead, it is a compassionate choice that enhances the patient's wellbeing.

While Hospice care is typically meant for a person of any age who is expected to live less than six months, receiving Hospice care does not necessarily mean that the person will die soon. In fact, some people live longer under hospice care than if they were to continue curative treatments.

Hospice care isn't just about the person facing the illness; it's a support system for caregivers too. Everyone deserves to navigate this challenging journey with knowledge, compassion and the assurance that they are not alone.

The Benefits of Canine Therapy

Army Reserve Sergeant First Class and dedicated HosPet volunteer Paul Kelly could not have imagined he'd be comfortable training service dogs and regularly interacting with others again after experiencing a brain injury on the battlefield in Afghanistan. Facing overwhelming challenges including anxiety, depression and difficulty sleeping or being in crowds, Paul was diagnosed with Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) upon returning home. It was when Paul decided to forego applying for a service dog and instead apply to help train them that his recovery journey took an unexpected, life-changing turn.

Paul connected with Warrior Canine Connection of Boyds, Maryland, an organization that enlists the help of veterans in training service dogs for other veterans in need. The program offers more than just dog training; it serves as a source of significant therapeutic benefits for veterans like Paul.

Through their involvement, veterans learn essential skills such as patience, emotional regulation and improved communication. In Paul's case, the program not only helped him cope with depression and anxiety but also allowed him to interact more comfortably with others.

“It’s because of Warrior Canine Connection that I am here today,” says Paul. “I thought I was just volunteering to help another vet. I didn’t realize at the time that it was helping me, too.”

Despite trying other forms of therapy before joining, none proved as effective as working with the dogs. Paul's improvements are a testament to the program's unique impact on his healing.

“I’m able to interact with people now because of Warrior Canine Connection. It was the perfect healing process,” says Paul.

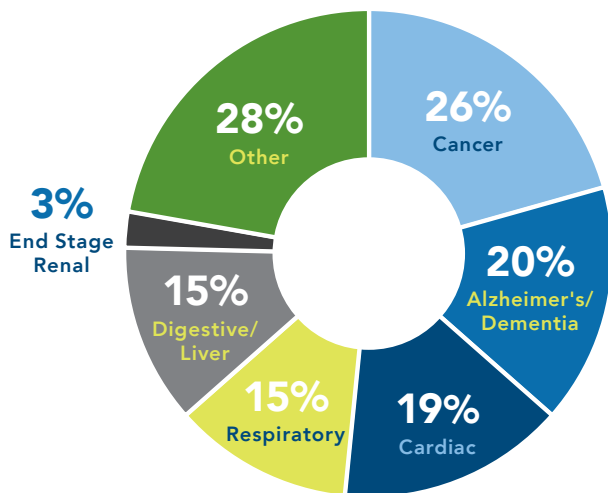

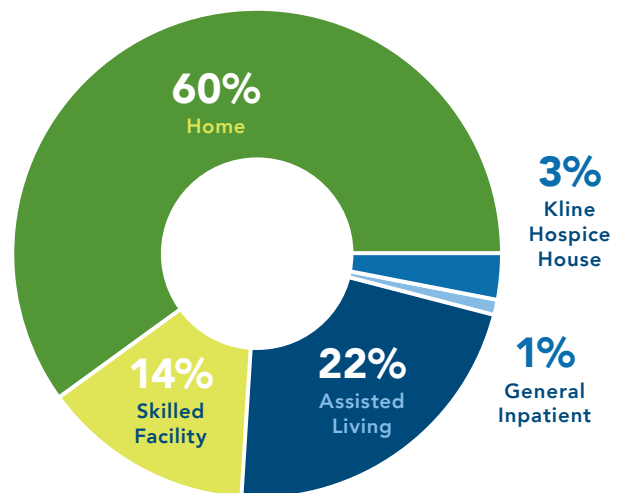
